Friday - 9th July: Meet at The Star Pub in Chessington with full tanks please to depart promptly at 1.00pm. It's around 110 miles on the M25, M3, A303 and the A36 to our Hotel just outside the centre of Frome. So with a break around halfway we should arrive around 5.00pm. We will be staying for the two nights at The Premier Inn which costs £132.00 for a double room, buffet breakfast is extra; for more details go to www.premierinn.com. The Hotel has a large selection of meals and specials to suit every pocket or SIZE of meal you require.

Saturday - 10th July: Kickstands up at 10.15am to leave the Hotel and head for Longleat Safari Park around 45mins away; more info at www.longleat.co.uk.



For a group price of £16.10 each, (£13.30 for concessions), we will be able to enjoy no less than eleven attractions. There is also a Safari Bus Tour of the Park for a supplement of £5.00 each, Longleat House & Grounds, and much more. You will be able to spend the day there as you wish, but a fixed time will have to be agreed for the Safari Bus Park Tour. We anticipate leaving the Park at 5.30pm and will be back at the Hotel by 6.15pm. We can have dinner in the Hotel but it's no problem venture into Town for alternative eats.

Sunday - 11th July: Kickstands up to leave at 11.00am with a non-motorway ride around the Marlborough & Berkshire Downs through small towns and villages where we will stop briefly for tea and coffee. We will then continue to a country pub for lunch at 1.30pm. Leaving the pub at 3.00pm, we will head for Reading and the M4 home arriving at The Star at approximately 5.00pm in plenty enough time to see ENGLAND lift the World Cup!
