

**Manx Tails TT (Teddy's Tours) Thursday 9<sup>th</sup> to Monday 13<sup>th</sup> September**

The Isle of Man may only be 11 miles across and 35 miles long but it's a bikers' paradise and this is a trip not to be missed. We will leave Dorking around lunchtime on Thursday afternoon and travel up to Liverpool to catch an evening boat across to the Isle of Man. We will stay at a top hotel with underground parking right on the seafront of the Capital City – Douglas. So there will be plenty to do in the evenings.

On our first of the three days on the island Tedwood will use his local knowledge to lead us on a ride around the famous TT circuit but at speeds more suitable for a Teddy's Tour on a Harley than on a Tupperware Torpedo. We'll stop off at the famous motorcycle museum at "The Bungalow".



Then, once we have climbed all over this huge water wheel at Laxey we'll have the option of a ride on the scenic mountain railway to the very summit of Snaefell Mountain which at 621 metres is the highest point on the island.

The next day we will take in the sights of Port Erin, Port St Mary and Castletown in the beautiful south of the Island. Our third day will include Peel and the Point of Ayre in the north of the island and some retail therapy back in Douglas.

We'll catch the 08:45 boat back to the mainland on Monday morning which gives us a nice leisurely ride back home. If you like kippers as delicate as smoked salmon, mountain scenery, no motorways, no caravans and little other traffic then this is the island to visit!

Costs per couple are around £134 for the return ferry (special offers may exist for early bookings) and 4 nights in the hotel for £350. Single riders will be a bit less.
