

## **Malvern Waters: Saturday 4<sup>th</sup> to Monday 6<sup>th</sup> September**

Please note the dates have changed since the original proposal.

On Saturday we will leave from the Hampton Court Railway Station car park at 9.30 sharp for the ride to Malvern which is about 120 miles. Lunch will be at The Plough PH at Ford. We'll have a ride on the Warwickshire Steam Railway ([www.gwsr.com](http://www.gwsr.com)) en route to the hotel ([www.malvernhillshotel.co.uk](http://www.malvernhillshotel.co.uk)) which is in the lee of the Herefordshire Beacon, an ancient hill fort. Dinners are arranged to be taken in a special dining room and are included in the hotel price.

On Sunday we'll leave at 9.30am for a 60 mile ride, via Ludlow for coffee, to Iron Bridge Gorge which was the birth place of the industrial revolution.



After a light lunch and look around we'll move on to the Blists Hill Victorian Village ([www.ironbridge.org.uk](http://www.ironbridge.org.uk)).

On Monday we'll leave at 9.30 and go on to the Morgan Car Company for a two hour factory tour. Afterwards we'll stop for lunch and plan to be back in Surrey by 5.00pm.

The hotel will cost £300 for a lovely double room with freshly cooked breakfasts and evening meals both nights. Entry to the events total £31 per adult and £28.50 per senior. (The train is £9.90 adult & £8.50; the Victorian Village is £11.00 adult & £10.50; the Morgan factory is £10.00 for everyone). Fuel and lunches will be extra.

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
